Cape Cod Commission Executive Director 208 Update

- All consultant contracts have been signed
- Sub-regional meetings to take place July 15<sup>th</sup>-18<sup>th</sup>. Outer Cape meeting took place in Wellfleet last night. Attendance was good, about forty attendees, local environmental groups were strongly represented.
- Consensus Building Institute has begun the stakeholder selection process. Each watershed group will consist of 8 designated seats (representatives from environmental group, alternatives group, civic group, elected officials) and 5-7 open seats. Individuals who are interested are to fill out a form and self-identify which group they represent. CBI has used this process in the past and it has worked successfully.
- Robert Churchill asked for a list of watershed group meeting dates and stakeholder form so that he could distribute to groups he is connected with.
- Cape-2-0 will begin Monday of next week.
- The Alternatives Technology Matrix has been sent to DEP and EPA for review. And will be sent to the Advisory Board for their review by the end of the day.
- Advisory Board will have a designated section on the 208 website.
- The TAC is to be set up over the next week. Towns are to designate a staff person to sit on the committee.
- Fertilizer DCPC under discussion. Towns would have the choice to opt in. A fertilizer bylaw may be part of the 208 update.
